Pat's gallery associations have included Wild Child Art Gallery, The Gallery of Matlacha, the Alliance for the Arts, Matlacha Menagerie and, most recently, Sea Legs Art Gallery in Tarpon Springs, FL - in addition to shows at the Cape Coral Art League where she's been awarded many ribbons for her work.
